All babies come from God. God creates babies in His Factory of Human Life inside of a woman's body. God responds to the love and affection that a man and a woman will show for each other when He will decide to give them a baby to love and to cherish for the rest of their lives.

Parents of newborn babies need special guidance and training from God. Parents of newborn babies need to find God by accepting the gift of a human life that God has given to them to love and to develop into an adult for the rest of their lives.

What does it mean when parents of a newborn baby must find God? It means that God helps parents to understand a baby's thoughts. God helps parents to understand a baby's needs and what they have to do to meet those needs. God has to train parents in how to properly care for a newborn baby. God develops special relationships with the baby and with the baby's parents. This three-way relationship happens when the parents of newborn babies succeed in finding God.

Parents have to pray to God for guidance, support, and understanding when they have to deal with the stresses of raising a newborn baby. They must understand that a newborn baby is part of their relationship with God. They must understand that a baby is an act of God. Parents work for God by agreeing to work together to develop a new human life.

Intimacy after Childbirth

Many women feel the obligation to abuse contraception after childbirth and to continue to engage in intimacy with her partner or husband. Many women feel that a man and a woman have to show love for each other after childbirth.

What is birth control? Birth control is an effort to stop God from creating a new human life inside of His Factory of Human Life inside of a woman during the process of intercourse that may result in an unplanned pregnancy. The man and the woman work hard to ask God to create a human life inside of the woman and also tell God that they do not want a new human life in their lives at the same time.

Does God feel insulted when a man and a woman persistently try to get pregnant and persistently try to refuse to become pregnant at the same time? The real problem with couples that use birth control is very basic. They do not understand that sexual activity and sexual intercourse are part of our relationships with God. These are mechanisms that we use to work with God to bring new human lives into this world. Do these mechanisms have any other constructive purpose? Maybe they do and maybe they do not.

They have not conducted enough studies to understand whether using birth control after a child birth actually injures a woman or that it might injure a marriage or an intimate relationship. Does a woman suffer when she is trying to get pregnant and when she is making a strong effort to prevent a pregnancy at the same time? Does the abuse of birth control represent an effort by men to exploit and to abuse women? Every woman has to make their own decisions about the benefits and consequences of using birth control.

Does a woman have anything to gain by engaging in sexual activity after childbirth? She might want to become pregnant again. However, is sexual activity necessary if she does not want to get pregnant again? Is sexual intimacy necessary with a woman with an exhausted reproductive system. These are ideas that woman should think about during and after a pregnancy.

Post-Partum Depression

A childbirth is supposed to bring joy and happiness to a woman's life. Most woman think that a childbirth is a wonderful gift from God.

Why would some women be severely depressed following a childbirth? They may feel depression if they have been homosexual or bisexual in the past. That means that they have spent a considerable amount of time rejecting the achievement of parenthood in their lives. That feeling that a woman has children but wants to have a sexual life with contraception without the burden of achieving parenthood is a conflict with their relationship with God.

A woman can tell God that she wants to engage in homosexual and/or bisexual relationships for long period in their lives can suddenly find themselves in the role of a parent in front of God. This confrontation with God can cause severe conflict and sadness.

A woman that is used to using birth control may decide to try to become pregnant at some point. The fact that the woman had been engaged in sexual activity for a considerable length of time without achieving parenthood may also cause feelings of severe sadness because of idea that the woman had been exploited by a male partner.

God Helps Us to Deal with Baby Stress

Caring for a newborn can be very stressful. The demands on a mother and father of a newborn can be overwhelming. Many parents may feel that the combined financial demands and meeting the needs of newborn babies can make them want to give up trying.

God wants to be a resource for parents that feel that they cannot adequately perform their jobs in their careers and as parents. God gives these types of parents moral and spiritual support. God wants to help parents to find ways to be successful in jobs and to be successful in caring for their newborn babies and for their older kids.

God is also very conscience of the toll that these stressors can take on a marriage. God is very hurt and is very disappointed when a marriage that involves children collapses and ends in separation and divorce. God wants to do everything that He can to save all of His families and all of His marriages that exist out there right now.

God can exploit the relationships that He will have with a husband and a wife to try to lead them to get help when their marriage and their ability to execute the responsibilities of parenthood seem to be deteriorating. God needs all parents and married couples that He deeply cares about them. He wants them to find happiness and fulfillment in their roles as spouses and as parents.

God wants to guide our parents and married couples to get counseling and assistance in raising their child. Marriage counselors might be able to understand what the nature of the conflict is that might be causing the conflict in the couple's relationship. Marriage counselors could also help them to understand why raising a baby is so stressful.

God wants all marriages that involves babies to succeed. He will employ all of His resources to help us to succeed as husbands, wives, and parents.

How Does Marital Conflict Injure a Baby?

Babies have unforeseen emotions. They can sense that their parents are suffering and that they are hurting each other. Babies depend on parents that have a healthy relationship to teach them how to emerge into being a toddler. Conflict between a mother and father automatically hurts the development of a baby.

The main goal in the early stages of developing a baby is to make the baby happy and at peace with his or her home and with his or her relationships with his or her parents. Parents automatically injure a baby when their babies sense conflict in their marriage that gives the baby the impression that his or her parents no longer love each other.

Parents have to be considerate of the damage that can happen to the development of their baby if they contemplate ending their relationship. The baby does not want to sense that his or her father and mother might not love each other anymore.

We have to remember that a baby is a human being. A baby has emotions. A baby can face pain and suffering. A baby can understand much more that we can believe that a baby can understand. We have to understand that marital conflict between the parents of the baby automatically hurts the baby. Parents should think twice about sabotaging the development of their babies and children by elevating the conflict and by thinking that ending a marital relationship will solve their problems.

Understanding What Hurts a Baby

There are many red flags that will tell parents that babies are in pain. The most obvious red flag is that the baby will be crying for no apparent reason. A baby can hug the baby to console him or her. A parent can struggle to understand what has gone wrong. A baby cannot talk. God can sometimes help parents to hear a baby's thoughts. God can intervene in the situation to help the couple to understand what they can do to stop the baby's suffering.

The most obvious problem is that the baby wants to drink his or her formula or that he or she wants to eat something. That can be very understandable. God has no problems in helping parents to understand when they need to provide formula and food to a baby.

Babies can become lonely. Babies get scared when they feel alone and by themselves. They cry because they want someone to give them attention so that they will not continue to be alone in a crib or in a stroller. Babies always need to be in the presence of a parent or a guardian.

Babies get scared when they are in a location that is completely alien to them. They cry out of fear because they have no idea where they are.

Babies cry when they are sick. Sometimes they may have to pass gas. Parents would need to give a baby a medication to help him or her to pass gas. The buildup of gas in a baby's intestines can be extremely painful for a baby. The baby might have another illness such as a fever or a bacterial infection. God helps parents to understand when crying means that a baby needs to go to a doctor or an emergency room as soon as possible.

Parents must work with God to make sure that the diet of a baby will not injure the baby's digestive system or other parts of his or her body. God can be a real help to parents to find the source of the pain when they do not know what is causing the pain.

The Consequences of Ignoring a Baby's Pain

Parents cannot persistently ignore the red flags that their baby is experiencing pain. This pain might be physical pain. This pain might be emotional pain. The baby might just be irrational. The truth of the matter is that parents must immediately respond to their baby's distress.

God helps parents to understand the source of a baby's pain. God wants a baby to have a healthy development as he or she attempts to enter the next phase of his or her life which is the toddler stage.

Babies need to feel love and happiness. God wants them to exist in a state that is completely free of pain. God wants babies to learn to feel joy with their new lives. God wants babies to experience the love of an entire human family that will not allow them to feel any amount of pain for any extended period of time.

God does not want the pain that a baby might be feeling to progress into a disability for the baby when he or she enters the toddler stage of his or her development. The baby might develop an emotional disability or a physical disability if we do not work with God to identify the baby's source of pain and to adequately remove that source of pain. We can never allow babies to feel any type of pain for any given amount of time.

God loves His babies very much. God wants to play a major role in the development of babies and toddlers. God wants them to be free of any ideas that would help them to justify hurting themselves or hurting others. God wants our babies to emerge as toddlers and children that will live fulfilling lives that will be productive and that will bring happiness to humanity.

The Toddler Years

The Challenge to Communicate

Toddlers spend a long time in trying to understand how to communicate with parents, family members, peers, and other persons. God challenges our toddlers to not only listen to their spoken language. God wants them to be able to speak in their native language.

These toddlers have been developing the capacity to speak and to engage in conversations from the time that they were born. God had been developing their brain and their body to a state where they would be able to engage in spoken communications and conversations. God is the Supreme Being that give our babies the mental and physical capacity to talk, to hear, and to understand a spoken language.

It can be a struggle for a toddler to develop a vocabulary. It can be a challenge for a toddler to come to understand how to identify a work with an object that the word represents. Toddlers may have more problems with abstract words that describe emotions and feelings.

God has a personal relationship with all of our toddlers. God takes it upon Himself to work with the toddler's parents and family members to teach them how to understand the spoken language. God helps toddlers to develop their spoken vocabulary. God helps toddlers to understand the way to speak the most common words that human beings use on a daily basis. God tries to help toddlers to understand what they are seeing on television or at the movies.

Parents sometimes do not realize that God is involved in the process of maturation of their toddlers. Parents just take it for granted that toddlers wake up one day and the they can just talk. Parents make God sick when they do not recognize His role in helping them to raise their kids.

The Development of Social Skills

God wants to work with parents to help toddlers to develop positive and constructive social skills. There are many different programs that parents could utilize in order to help a toddler to develop constructive social skills.

Daycare centers offer an environment where toddlers socialize with each other long hours for up to five days a week. It is very productive for a toddler to be developing social skills under the supervision of licensed daycare supervisors. Young toddlers can learn how to form constructive relationships with both other toddlers and with adults in a safe environment.

God plays a major role in the way that daycare centers function. God stimulates the ability of daycare centers to develop the social skills, the speaking skills, and the athletic skills of the toddlers in these programs. God stimulates the way that daycare centers allow toddlers to face exposure to love from other toddlers and from daycare social workers.

God wants His toddlers to learn how to socialize and to communicate with each other and with adults in a safe and supervised environment. God wants to work with multiple toddlers at the same time when He tries to teach them how to love each other and to teach them how to communicate with each other.

God wants daycare center experiences to help toddlers to have constructive relationships with their parents and sibling by teaching them about more advanced communications skills.

God Understands Problems with Toddlers

God knows that there are some toddlers that are more difficult to discipline than other toddlers. We should all work with God to try to work with psychiatrists and therapists to identify the source of misbehavior of a toddler. We cannot give toddlers the idea that we can tolerate his or her repeated efforts to misbehave.

Some toddlers mature more slowly than other toddlers. It takes longer for these types of toddlers to completely learn how to communicate with others and to grasp basic social skills. We have to work with God, educators, therapists, and psychiatrists to develop programs that will help these toddlers to catch up to their fellow toddlers.

We cannot just allow a toddler to fall behind in his or her maturation without working with God to do whatever we can to help that toddler. We must utilize the power of God to help our toddlers to overcome disabilities and learning difficulties.

God understands why some toddlers are disruptive and disobedient. We need to work with therapists and psychiatrists to learn how to work with God to save the lives of our problem toddlers that fail to respond to discipline at least part of the time. We have to find ways to make sure that toddlers with behavioral problems will have access to the treatment programs that will save their lives in the future. We have to save the lives of our toddlers if they show signs of developing a mental illness.

We should always pray to God when we need guidance and support that we will need in order to help our young toddlers that seem to be in trouble and that are behaving abnormally. God will be there for us if we believe that God loves all of us and especially if he loves His toddlers.

Exercise and Fighting Obesity

It is very healthy for our toddlers to exercise every day. A two to five block walk that lasts for twenty minutes can be very beneficial to a toddler. Toddlers can exercise in preparation to pursue their participation in athletic programs later when they are young adults and adults.

God wants all of us to develop some time of athletic ability. God wants us to be able to show that we are athletes to some extent. God wants to see the athlete in us because He wants to see us living a long life.

The fight against obesity starts when we are toddlers. A simple exercise program such as walking can allow our toddlers to enjoy a healthy diet without worrying about becoming obese. God wants all of us to fight obesity in our toddler years, child years, and young adult years.

We want to look attractive to the member of the opposite gender that might be ready to sweep us off of our feet. We would want to minimize the possibility that we would be candidates for heart disease or for other diseases such as a stroke or high blood pressure.

Exercise is a very healthy activity. We should teach our toddler how to deal with it and how to tolerate it. We should help our toddlers to understand the benefits of weekly exercise. We should help our toddlers to understand the kind of healthy body that they will have when they will exercise regularly. We should ask God in a prayer whether He thinks that we should exercise. We might be surprised by His response. God might want us to set aside time every week to exercise with our children and toddlers.

When Do We Teach Toddlers to Pray?

It is very important for our toddlers to understand that they answer to God. It is important for our toddlers to start to get used to reaching out to God for love, help, and support in their lives. This process should begin in the toddler years.

What do we say to toddlers about God? We should say that our toddlers all come from God. God assigns the care of a toddler to a husband and wife that will care for the baby and/or toddler. We have to help them to understand some of the important roles that God will play in our lives in the future. We have to help them to understand that our relationship with God protects us from facing pain, suffering, and bodily harm throughout our lives.

Our toddlers must understand that we all have to show love for God by engaging in daily prayer to Him. Our toddlers should understand that we all need to talk to God every day. Our toddlers must understand that God wants to hear from us every day. It is our obligation to communicate with God on a daily basis.

Our toddlers must understand the importance of believing in God and in praying to God in times when they feel that they are in trouble. We must teach our toddlers that it is good to ask God for help when something goes wrong. Our toddlers should understand how to go to God and to adults when something goes wrong in their lives.

We must begin to help our toddlers to understand the benefits of praying to God. We must help them to understand the benefits of praying to God as part of our relationship with God.

God Develops the Toddlers' Aptitude to Learn

God wants all of His toddlers to achieve success in Kindergarten, grammar schools, in middle schools, and high schools.

No one really knows how God develops the brain of a toddler. No one knows how God develops the aptitude of a toddler in order to help the toddler to function as a student in a grammar school. No one understands exactly how the mechanism of the brain operates in the toddler years.

However, God is a Supreme Force that knows how to develop the physiology of a toddler so that the toddler will have the ability to function as a successful student in grammar school.

God is a force that lives inside the bodies of all of our toddlers. This force is the source of our life. This force heals us when we are sick. This force helps us to understand the Will of God and helps us to understand how to achieve the will of God.

Our toddlers and grammar-school students do not always recognize the presence of God in their lives. However, God is there to help all of us. This is especially true of our toddlers. God can help us even though we do not really detect His presence in our lives.

God develops all of us into adults that can learn. God helps all of our toddlers to begin to make the journey to become successful students. God is part of that success throughout the lives of our toddlers.

The Child Years

God Teaches Children Academic Skills

God guides our young children when they begin to learn their basic academic skills in Kindergarten. God helps our young boys and girls to understand the alphabet. God helps our young students to understand how to count. God helps our students to understand how to show respect for the United States by working with educators to help them to sing "God Bless America" and to recite the "Pledge of Allegiance."

Teachers can put a young first grade student in front of a textbook in the first grade. However, can a teacher actually explain how to read to a young student that has just learned his or her alphabet Kindergarten? Do educators need help to help students to grasp essential skills in reading, writing, and arithmetic? That is probably true.

God has a special relationship with each of our young children in Kindergarten and in the lower grades from the 1st Grade to the 4th Grades. God works with educators to guide students to understand reading, writing, and arithmetic. God helps to guide our students to grasp the most basic skills that they will need throughout their academic careers. God wants all of His students to succeed in being able to understand how to read, how to count, and how to write.

Educators sometimes take it for granted that students just learn these basic skills. They rarely think about the role of God that help them to work with their students to accomplish learning goals. Teachers sometimes do not immediately recognize their own relationship with God when they work to motivate their students to achieve success in their courses by working with God to do so.

God is a special and powerful force in a young student's life. Teachers need God's help in order to produce students that can succeed in grasping the most basic skills that they will need in order to achieve success throughout their academic careers and after their academic careers end.

God loves our students and teachers. God wants to show love for our students and teachers by helping them to succeed in the lower grades (Kindergarten to 4th Grades) to help them to succeed in their lives.

God Stimulates Social Functioning

God wants to help our students to understand how to love each other. God wants our students to understand the benefits of engaging in constructive communications and interactions with other students. God wants our younger students to understand how to be sociable, friendly, and kind to other students and to other people in general.

Social functioning between children is about working with God to help our children to understand how to talk to one another and how to understand each other. God wants our young children to understand the benefits of socializing with their peers. God wants young peers to benefit from His efforts to encourage them to be friends in a social environment such as a grammar school.

God operates to help our kids in both public and religious schools. God works to develop the social skills and the interrelationships of all of our children in all of our schools. Our students do not necessarily have to notice that God is stimulating their effort to engage in constructive friendships. Our students sometimes do not realize why they pray to God every day. Our educators sometimes do not know the consequences that our children will face when they do not recognize the existence of God in their lives.

God is a part of all of the social relationships that our children attempt to achieve in their early academic years. God teaches them how to socialize and how to benefits from social activity.

Establishing an Attachment to God

God wants our children to find Him in their lives. God wants children to communicate with Him through prayer. God wants children to respond to the love that God shows for them. God loves our children through their parents, their family members, their educators, their peers, and medical professionals that seek to care about them.

An Attachment to God is a commitment to God that a young child makes that he or she will try hard to work with God to achieve success in their lives. These young kids will work with God to make sure that they will not disgrace God or their parents. A student honors God by achieving an Attachment to God through the way that he or she brings happiness to his or her parents and to his or her educators by succeeding in school and in peer relationships.

An Attachment to God means that a young student will pray to God every day. It means that a young student will attempt to respond to the will of God as best as he or she can. An Attachment to God means that our young students will work to help other students who need help on behalf of God. God expects all of our kids to adopt the attitude that they should work with God to help others that are in distress and that are in danger of succumbing to life-threatening problems.

Children that achieve an Attachment to God bring joy and happiness to their educators, their peers, their parents, and to God Himself. God loves the way that these types of children bring joy to all of our lives and to His life. These are the type of children that like to honor God through their attitudes and their willingness to achieve the creation and maintenance of loving relationships in their lives. God appreciates the opportunity to help student that achieve an Attachment to God.

The Consequences of a Detachment from God

It is unfortunate that some students believe that they have the right to ignore the existence of God in their lives. Their educators and their parents make these students believe that they can ignore God without facing the consequences of doing so. Some students are groomed to ignore the existence of God. Some students do not care about the role that God wants to play in their lives. Some students ignore God when God tries to guide them.

It is a very sad situation when young students in the lower grades of a grammar school have the idea that it does not matter whether or not God really exists in their lives. It is a sad story when no one can warn our young students about the dangers that await them when they think that God will tolerate the way that they think and fantasize about hurting themselves and about hurting others.

Agnosticism is very detrimental to the development of a young child. Young children cannot have the impression that they can go on through their lives while ignoring the love of God that worked with the student's parents to bring him or her into the world. We must teach our students to recognize the existence of God in their lives and to understand the benefits of communicating with God and loving God through prayer and through fulfilling His will in our lives.

Both public and private schools must understand the consequences that follow a student that ignores the existence of God in his or her life. The student may resort to a life of crime. The student may resort to hurting himself or herself with illegal drugs. The student might think that he has something to gain by hurting others. Students must understand that we all answer to God and we have no right to injure ourselves and/or to injure others and that we will face penalties for doing so.

God Needs to Get a Child Psychiatric Treatment

There are times when a child's misbehaviors are the result of a psychiatric illness. There are times when a child will need psychiatric treatment and psychological counseling. Parents and educators must understand that their obligations to God require them to try to save the lives of their students by getting them help as soon as they detect that something is seriously wrong with the child.

Our educators have more to gain by getting a misbehaving student psychiatric help to try to stop his or her misbehavior. Educators have nothing to gain by engaging in a persistent campaign of harmful discipline against a student that is mentally ill. Our educators must understand that mentally ill children need love, patience, and psychiatric treatment. Mentally ill children do not need discipline that will make them even more mentally ill and even more depressed.

Parents and educators must recognize the warning signs that something is wrong with the way that a child is behaving. Parents and educators that work with God all of the time should reach a general agreement about how to deal with a misbehaving child. They may come to feel that God would want a psychiatrist and a therapist to evaluate the child to see if the child would be a candidate for psychiatric treatment.

It is much more productive to treat a misbehaving child that is mentally ill with psychiatric treatment and psychological counseling than by a campaign of harmful discipline that would further hurt the child.

Educators must provide a child that has a psychiatric disability with reasonable accommodations so that the student has a realistic chance to function in his or her school. We should encourage such children with a psychiatric disability to pray to God and to look to God for help and guidance.

How God Functions with Child Psychiatry

Psychiatrists are psychiatrists because God wants them to be medical doctors that can treat human beings with psychiatric disorders. God sometimes needs help from psychiatrists to deal with children that seem to be mentally ill. Child psychiatrists need to work with educators and parents to save the lives of children that are in jeopardy of falling apart with no chance of recovering from their disaster.

God trusts child psychiatrists to help young kids in grammar schools who have to deal with a wide range of behavioral problems. God guides patients such as children to get psychiatric help whenever it is possible. God feels that child psychiatrists come to love their patients. They wish the best for their grammar school students.

The one thing that child psychiatrists do not understand is that a child's misbehaviors and psychiatric problems may be as a result of a child's detachment from God. A child may be missing the love of God in his or her life. The child may not be able to receive help from God because he or she cannot pray or understand how God helps kids in grammar schools. The students would want to ignore God because he or she would feel that the school would be encouraging him or her to do so.

The general feeling is that most psychiatric disorders are interconnected with a problem with a patient's relationship with God or a loved one that disappears from a person's life. The presence of God in a child's life is a good thing. A relationship with God can be a healing mechanism for a child.

Psychotherapy for a Mentally Ill Child

Psychotherapists work with children that have psychiatric disorders. These students may need to discuss very important issues that aggravate the children's medical condition.

A therapist helps a young child to understand reality. A therapist helps a student to understand that he or she has to stop behaving in a way that hurts themselves and that hurts others. A therapist has to help a student to recognize why he or she feels pain and suffering in his or her life.

Should a therapist talk about God and religion? God is a healing force for all of us that become sick. That goes for physical illnesses as well as mental illnesses. Therapists should seriously consider bringing God into the lives of our students who have mental illness as part of their psychotherapy.

Therapists have to discipline children in peaceful ways that do not hurt them. Therapists have to find ways to work with parents to reward students for improvements in the child's behaviors. Parents, educators, psychiatrists, and therapists must work together to give healthy children as well as mentally ill children rewards for making a strong effort to make progress in their studies and to improve their behaviors in their school and in their home.

Psychotherapists must work with parents to understand what other factors might be aggravating the symptoms of their child so that they will promote bad behaviors and destructive behaviors.

Our schools need to have psychiatrists and psychotherapists that will work together to treat all children that misbehave or that need seen advice for their life-threatening issues. Schools must be ready to help their students to overcome their problems and their mental illnesses.

God Teaches between Right and Wrong

God wants our children to understand the difference between right and wrong. God wants our children to understand the benefits of doing things the right way. God wants our children to understand the consequences of committing sins and breaking laws.

It is so important to God that we should teach our kids in grammar schools the basic skills about crimes and sins that they will need so that they will avoid incarceration and prosecution.

God wants our educators and law enforcement officers to teach our young kids about how prisons will await them if they decide to commit crimes later in their lives. Law enforcement officers should teach our kids about drug dealing on the streets, what happens when you use a gun to hurt others, and what happens when you drive drunk.

Our law enforcement officers should talk to our kids about the benefits that will await them if they will intend to become law-abiding tax payers that will function in legal jobs.

They will talk to our children about completing their education. They will talk to our children about getting a good job. They will talk to our children about starting a family. They will talk to our children about enjoying a life of freedom without being arrested or charged with a crime.

Our law enforcement officers must help our students to understand that illegal drugs are a dead end street that will ruin their lives. They will tell our kids about what it is like to be arrested for using and dealing drugs. They will talk to our kids about how drugs destroy people's lives.

The Importance of Communicating with God

God wants to be a part of the life of every one of His children. God wants to make a difference for the better in the lives of all of His children. God wants to be able to communicate with children all of the time and when He feels that it is necessary.

Young students that learn how to pray and to communicate with God at a young age find it easier to achieve success when they become young adults and adults. God always wants to guide our child students to be sociable and friendly with peers and adults. God wants to teach kids how to function as Part of God and as Part of Humanity.

God wants to challenge our kids to talk to Him even if they do not have any issues to discuss with Him. God wants kids to get into the habit of reaching out to Him at a very young age. This is because this gives God the maximum opportunity of guiding them in the right way when they become young adults and adults.

Our kids need to communicate with God for many different reasons. God helps our kids to understand complex concepts in their studies in grammar schools. God helps our kids to begin to deal with the stress of understanding the difference between positive peer pressure and negative peer pressure. God wants to communicate with our kids to persuade them not to resort to using illegal drugs, tobacco, or alcohol.

God wants to be able to communicate with our kids when they get into trouble. God wants to work with mentors in order to teach kids how to do things the right way. God wants kids to learn from their mistakes and to understand that God can help them to make sure that they will not make the same mistake again. These are all reasons why God wants to have daily interactions with our kids.

How God Helps Kids to Deal with Peer Pressure

God helps our young students to understand when their peers are asking them to do something that helps them to succeed. God help His kids to understand when peers are asking kids do somethings that are harmful to themselves and that are harmful to others. God wants to stop our kids from doing things that will cause self-inflicted injuries and inflicted injuries upon others. God wants to intervene in any situation where negative peer pressure can cause serious emotional and physical injury to his young kids in grammar schools.

God wants to form an attachment with all of His kids in grammars schools. He wants to be able to guide them in their thoughts and in their behaviors. God feels hurt when he cannot stop teachers and parents from punishing kids for committing wrongdoing and engaging in misbehavior.

God wants to find numerous ways to teach His kids how to behave themselves properly so that they can exist in schools without feeling the pain, humiliation, and suffering that comes from facing discipline for misbehaviors and for violations of the school's rules and regulations.

A rejection of God's advice and guidance could cause young kids to think that he or she can get away with breaking the rules of their school. God has to work with parents and educators to help kids to understand who they answer to. Kids answer to God, their parents, and their educators. They have to pray every day so that God can help them to follow the rules, to avoid punishment, and to behave the right way so that God, their parents, their educators and their other family members will be proud of them. God wants to be happy and proud when He can guide a His kids the right way to succeed.

Preparing Parents and Educators for Puberty

Children enter into young adulthood at some point. This means that God begins to work with His kids to begin the long process of preparing them to achieve adulthood, parenthood, and their career. God has to work with educators and parents in order to try to make sure that this long process will not result in serious emotional and/or bodily injury to any of His young adults.

How do we explain puberty to our kids? God wants us to be honest with our kids. Puberty is a time in a young adult's life when he or she prepares to face his or her destiny. It is a time when a young adult man or a young adult woman will choose their sexual orientation. It is a time when they will decide when to begin their initial dating process. It is a time when they will decide whether they will work with a partner of the opposite gender to become married and to participate with the process of conception with God.

We must be honest with our young adults about puberty. This is a time when they will try to prepare for achieving parenthood. This is a time when they will decide when they will become sexually active. This is a time to work with family planning experts to understand how God creates a human life inside of God's Factory of Human Life inside of a woman's body. This is a time when young adults work with God to understand their destiny and how to achieve their destiny.

It is a time when we will work with God to decide whether we will seek to achieve parenthood. Some young adults choose to refuse to achieve parenthood. It deeply hurts God when one of His young adults rejects their capability to achieve the conception and the development of human life in a relationship with a member of the opposite gender.

God wants our young adults to understand their capability to work with Him and with a member of the opposite gender to bring new human lives into the world in the future.

God and Developing Our Sexual Orientation

God's goal is to work with all of His children and young adults to achieve the conception and the development of human life. A child may start to decide whether he or she will want to pursue heterosexual parenthood. A child may start to decide whether he or she would want to pursue homosexual relationships.

We all have an obligation to God to participate in the conception and the development of new human lives. God expects us to reward Him for what He has done to bring us into the world. We reward God by achieving parenthood with a partner of the opposite gender. We reward God by loving and developing a new and beautiful human baby. We reward God for supporting our existence by helping Him to support the existence of other human beings as parents.

The purpose of God is to create and to maintain the existence of all human lives. We all have the capability to work with God and with a partner of the opposite gender to help Him to create human lives through sexual intimacy. We cannot be selfish toward God when we choose our sexual orientation as children and young adults. We must maintain a relationship with God that is respectful and productive.

We have to tell our children and young adults that we have to do whatever it takes to make God happy in order to give something back to Him for supporting our existence in His Universe.

Dealing with the First Crush

It is common for a boy or a girl that is close to entering into puberty will feel affectionate with another student. A boy in grammar school might like a girl which he would think is beautiful to him. Maybe he would want to be friends with her. This may happen with several students in the grammar school.

How do educators deal with crushes in the middle grades of a grammar school? Kids do not know what they are doing when they fantasize about dating each other when they are still in grammar school or even in high school. Kids do not understand what an attraction between a male and a female is all about. Kids do not understand why young adults go out on dates.

Grammar school crushes tend to disrupt the entire school. It causes gossip. It causes jealousy. It causes conflict. It causes rejection. It causes competition between kids and young adults who want to have puppy-love romances in a grammar school. Crushes are a distraction from the process of studying and learning the material that teachers present to students in the classroom.

It would be a good idea to assume that kids that have crushes in the third grade, fourth grade, fifth grade, or sixth grade are ready to enter puberty. Kids that are in higher grades are probably already in puberty. We have to be honest with our kids and young adults about what they will be facing during puberty.

Young kids and young adults in a grammar school or a middle school that fantasize about dating and engaging in sexual activity should be sent to family planning counseling. The government should pay for excellent Family Planning Counseling for all of our kids and young adults. The government should also pay for schools to allow young adults to see Family Planning Counselors that will help them to understand the right way to approach sexual intimacy and the wrong way to approach sexual intimacy.

God and Family Planning Counseling

God wants all of our young adults to understand how He makes the final decision to create a new human life when He experiences the loving intimacy between a man and a woman that seek to achieve parenthood.

God wants our kids and young adults to understand the consequences of behaviors that lead to the transmissions of sexually transmitted diseases. God wants our kids and young adults to understand the dangers of using contraceptive devices. God wants our kids and young adults to understand what happens with date rape and other types of rape. God wants His young adults to understand the emotional and physical consequences of engaging in sexual activity without the intent to work with God and with a partner to conceive a new human life.

Should young adults that have no way to assume the responsibility of parenthood be actually contemplating sexual activity with a partner of the opposite gender? Should a young adult in high school be concerned about being infected with a sexually transmitted disease if he or she should have a sexual relationship with a partner of the same gender? How does God feel about same-gender sexual activities? Does same-gender sexual activity accomplish anything for God? Does reckless young-adult sexual activity accomplish anything for God?

These are all problems that we have between our sexual attitudes and the way that God sees the problems that He has for us. We should have therapists that can investigate these problems.

Puberty and Taking God's Advice

God can give our kids that are entering puberty and that are in puberty intelligent advice about family planning issues. God can explain whether it is a right time for a young adult girl in high school to attempt to consummate a relationship with young adult boyfriend. God can help our young adults to make decisions about how they will and/or will not use contraception. God can help our young adults to understand the consequences of an under aged unplanned pregnancy. God can help our young adults to understand the wisdom of abstinence for a young adult that is not ready to assume the responsibilities of achieving parenthood.

God can help our students to understand just what puberty really does to them. God can help our young adults to understand the benefits of participating in the conception and the development of new human lives. God can help a boyfriend and a girlfriend to understand the menstrual cycle and how that works when the couple wants to work to achieve a pregnancy or does not want to achieve a pregnancy.

God really puts pressure on young adults to postpone intense sexual activity for later in life if He feels that sexual activity will ruin the lives of the young adult boy and the young adult girl. God will normally pressure a married couple to engage in passionate intimate sexual activity so that he can give them a new human life to develop through the process of conception and childbirth.

Young adults should understand that there will come a time when God will endorse their efforts to become sexually active in their lives. God will also put pressure on young adults to refrain from sexual activity if He feels that such behaviors may come to hurt them. God wants sexual activity to be productive when it helps Him to conceive and to give birth to a new human life. God does not want sexual activity to destroy the lives of His young adults.

God and Rejecting Alcohol, Drugs, and Weapons

All of our kids should understand that drinking alcohol and doing drugs is a sad story that makes God want to cry. God feels pain when a high school student starts to drink alcohol and starts to use illegal drugs. God feels that He has failed in that student's life when He sees the student's self-destruction with drugs.

God does not like alcohol. Alcohol is an addictive substance that makes people sick every time that they try to drink a fluid that contains it. It is a substance that a person drinks when he or she wants to hurt himself or herself. Alcohol has no positive purpose for existing in a person's body. Our kids and young adults should understand that alcohol is a dangerous waste of time. Our kids and young adults should reject all alcoholic beverages in order to preserve the balance of their health and safety. God would advise all of us to reject alcohol once and for all.

We also need to teach our kids and young adults that weapons are not good for us. Weapons are only good for two purposes. One purpose is to injure people. The second purpose is to kill people.

We need to teach our kids and young adults the consequences that await them when they try to use a weapon to commit a crime or to hurt another human being. Our kids and young adults must understand that they do not need to play games with owning a weapon. They can live a fulfilling life without spending most of their lives in prisons because of their fascination with using weapons. God does not want to incarcerates us because we think that it is legal to use weapons productively.

The Young Adult Years

Helping Children to Understand Puberty

It is important to help our children to understand that puberty is a period in our lives when we develop the potential and the capability to work with God and with a partner of the opposite gender to conceive a human life and to give birth to that human life. Our young children that enter into puberty must understand that God gives all of us the ability to work with Him to create and to develop all Human life.

God creates all human life in His Factory of Human Life inside of a woman. God creates a baby in the dark. It takes God about nine months of work to completely assemble a new human life before it is ready to face Humanity after childbirth. Many parents do not think about the role that God plays in the creation of a new human life during a pregnancy.

Our young adults enter a new era in their relationships with God when they enter puberty. This a time when God prepares them for the ability to participate in the creation of a new human life by engaging in sexual intimacy with a partner of the opposite gender.

The question is very simple. Do our young adults understand that the changes with their reproductive system happens because God wants to prepare them to have the potential to achieve a pregnancy and to achieve parenthood? Many young adults, educators, and parents do not think much about the role that God plays in a young adult's life when he or she is struggling with puberty. However, God remains in the background to help His young adults to try to make responsible decisions about their dating and their sexual activities.

We must help our young children that enter puberty the truth about what God is really doing to their bodies and to their potential to eventually become parents.

Working with God and Becoming Pregnant

God is responsible for the way that a woman will become pregnant after engaging in sexual intimacy with her male partner. God makes the decision to begin to create a human life in His Factory of Human Life inside of the woman after He is flattered by to loving intimacy that the man and the woman share with each other during sexual intercourse.

Our young adults must understand that sexual intercourse is a direct effort by a man and a woman to connect with God to convince Him to create a new human life for them. A man and a woman that will engage in sexual intercourse would want God to believe that they can become loving and responsible parents for a new child that God can bring into their lives.

God's purpose for existing is to always create and to develop new human lives throughout the universe. It is an honor for Him to respond to the sexual intimacy that a man and a woman would share with each other by creating a new human life and presenting that human life to them after childbirth. God wants to share in the happiness that parents of a newborn baby will achieve after a successful pregnancy. God creates all babies in His Factory of Human Life inside of a woman's body. God wants the father and mother to share in His happiness when they agree to develop a new human life for the rest of their lives. God wants young adults to understand the happiness that will await them if they choose to pursue and to achieve parenthood in their lives when they become adults.

The Young Adult Peer Pressure Crisis

God and the Holy Spirit help all of our young adults in our grammar schools, middle schools, high schools, and colleges to understand how they should deal with peer pressure.

Peer pressure is an effort by peers to convince a young adult to engage in either a constructive behavior or a destructive behavior. There is a lot of pressure for our young adults to drink alcohol on our college campuses and in our dorms. Our young adults that refuse to drink alcohol can be rejected by their peers.

Some peers might want a young adult to participate in a community service project. That is a constructive way to gain job experience and to serve the community. That is positive peer pressure.

Young adults might be at a party and might come under pressure to use illegal drugs. Where would they get the counseling and advice that will coach them into understanding that using drugs is completely unacceptable to them? They may face rejection from their peer group if they choose to reject an offer to use drugs.

Most young adults want peer groups to accept them in their schools. Young adults do not want to feel rejected, isolated, and alone. Young adults need a social life in our schools. It is painful when God spells it out for a young adult about a peer group that is engaged in destructive activities such as using alcohol and/or drugs. Sometimes it is better to be alone and rejected by a peer group than to be accepted by that peer group and to agree to use drugs and to drink alcohol. That is a decision that a young adult must make after God guides him or her to do the right thing about his or her peer pressure.

God and Substance Abuse Jeopardy

God does not want our young adults to use illegal drugs, tobacco, and/or alcohol. God wants to guide His young adults to understand the dangers and the consequences of using illegal drugs and alcohol. God want young adults to understand the way that they will be throwing their lives away if they use illegal drugs.

It is unfortunate that our schools do not do enough to teach our students about the realities that they face on the streets of their communities. Our educators do not show our young adults what life in prison is like. Educators do not show our students movies about the way that mentally ill substance abusers have destroyed their lives.

God and the Holy Spirit try so hard to persuade our young adults to be sensible and to stay away from illegal drugs and alcohol. They try so hard to warn our kids and young adults about the dangers that they will be facing if they use drugs and alcohol. God and the Holy Spirit do not want to lose our kids and young adults to the demon of substance abuse.

We have to develop educational programs for our young adult students that will teach them just how bad it is for them when they abuse illegal drugs and alcohol. We need to use instructors to teach our kids to reject illegal drugs all of the time for all of their lives.

We need to encourage our young adult students to look to God and to the Holy Spirit for guidance and for help when they are confronted with the decision as to whether or not to use illegal drugs and alcohol. Our young adults have to understand the reality of their self-destruction if they fail to understand the dangers of illegal street drugs.

No Tolerance for Under Aged Sexual Activity

There is no excuse for any school to endorse and/or to support the sexual exploitation of a young adult such as a high school student or as a college undergraduate.

Students have no way to support the development of a human life after childbirth. Students do not have jobs. Students cannot pay for reliable forms of birth control. Students do not understand how to negotiate with a marriage if both partners are unemployed and struggling in their schools.

Under aged sexual activity represents the exploitation of young adult girls and young adult boys. Under aged sexual activity offends God. God has a very difficult time with coming to tolerate under aged sexual activity.

Sometimes, young adults will date each other for a period of time. They may, at some point, agree to try to consummate the relationship. They may try to have sexual intercourse as a way of securing the fact that they are devoted to each other for an indefinite period of time. Consummation rituals among young adults can also be considered to be mutual sexual exploitation. This kind of exploitation serves no purpose if the young adult boy and the young adult girl are not trying to have a child.

The end of a young adult relationship between a young adult boy and a young adult girl that has involved graphic sexual activity can be emotionally devastating for both the boy and the girl. That is the kind of pain that comes from building a relationship that involves sexual activity without the intent to conceive a human life in young adulthood. God suffers very much when young adults have hurt each other by engaging in sexual activity as young adults to a point where they have severely injured each other.

Warnings about High-Risk Sexual Behaviors

There are times that God can be so hurt and so offended by our sexual behaviors that He may infect us with a sexually transmitted disease. God has created sexually transmitted diseases for His own reasons. God is at a point in human history when He can no longer tolerate the kinds of sexual behaviors that He is used to seeing on a daily basis all over the world.

We must help our young adults to understand how sexually transmitted diseases work. We must help them to understand how they can become infected with a sexually transmitted disease. We must help them to understand the behaviors that could make them a candidate for possibly becoming infected with sexually transmitted diseases.

God does not like to see an adult or a young adult that would have multiple sexual partners without the intent to conceive a new human life. God is very hurt when a young adult or an adult rejects their capability to achieve parenthood. God is very hurt when a man tries to get a man pregnant. God is very hurt when a woman tries to get a woman pregnant. God is very hurt when a man tries to get a man pregnant and a woman pregnant. God is very hurt when a woman tries to get pregnant with a man and tries to get a woman pregnant.

Nothing can hurt God more than a decision from our young adults to reject their capability to work with God and with a partner of the opposite gender to participate in the conception and the development of human life and to achieve parenthood. God sometimes completely loses His patience.

How Young Adults Discover Their Destiny

God has an individual plan for each and every young adult. All of us have a destiny that God gives to each and every one of us. God challenges us to play a specific role within the framework of God's Human Family.

God reveals His destiny for us during our young adult years. We naturally come to become interested in pursuing a certain career. We come to be attracted to a certain college in the future. We think about what kind of career we would want to pursue. We want to understand what occupation is best suited to our skills and capabilities.

God develops a special relationship with us when we enter young adulthood. God slowly lets young adults to understand how to gain the skills, reputation, and certifications to achieve our goals in our lives. God tries to persuade us to think about the benefits of a career that would be perfect for us. God will show us the benefits of achieving employment in a career that he has chosen for us.

The bottom line is that God wants us to pursue a career that will allow us to work with Him to help our brothers and sister here in this country and throughout the world. God wants young adults to pursue a career that will make them happy and will make them fulfilled.

God wants our young adults to achieve a successful family life. God wants our young adults to understand how to work with a spouse to maintain a household of children after they have achieved their destiny. God wants to guide our young adults to achieve love with a spouse and children after graduation from a school of higher learning and after childbirths with a spouse.

God is always there to make sure that the destiny that He has chosen for a young adult is the right destiny for the future of His young adult.

Young Adults and Better Relations with God

God is part of our lives from the time that we are born. We normally cannot understand God on a very mature level when we are children. However, we are more mature in the way that we can respond to God as young adults. God seeks a higher level of understanding about the way that He feels about young adult issues from His young adults.

Young adults have to be more responsible in the way that they respond to the issues and objections that God has with His young adults. Young adults have to show more maturity by not offending God through immature and irresponsible behaviors. Young adults have to respect the authority of God when it comes to making decisions about dating, their education, their peer relations, and the way that they will attempt to achieve their destiny.

God expects young adults to have a higher understanding about how He feels when young adults do things to get them into trouble. God wants young adults to be more receptive to His objections about the types of mistakes that they like to make that can compromise their safety and their status with law enforcement agencies.

God does not want our young adults to get into trouble with our law enforcement agencies. God does not want our young adults to be arrested or to commit any type of crime. God does not want our young adults to believe that they can get away with committing any type of crime. God wants to preserve the good reputation of His young adults so that they will continue to be successful in life.

Raging Hormones Disorders

God, educators, parents, counselors, and psychiatrists should understand that the changes in the balance of hormones in the bloodstream of a young adult can make him or her very sick.

Unprovoked sexual arousal in both young adult boys and young adult girls can be traumatic and very embarrassing. Young adult boys and young adult girls do not know how to deal with involuntary sexual arousal. They do not know what it is and they do not know how to deal with it.

Semen engorgement and smegma engorgement can lead to desperation for young adults. This is because they would want some way to release the fluid from their genitals. Sometimes, they would be driven to seek out a partner to help them to release the fluid that is residing in their genitals.

Young Adult Overdevelopment Disorder happens when a young girl or a young boy develops the ability to become pregnant at a much faster pace than their peers in a grammar school. This could lead to peer conflict, the pressure to start dating, and the pressure to experiment with sexual activity.

Young Adult Underdevelopment Disorder happens when young adult boys and young adult girls are "late bloomers." They tend to develop pubic hair, breasts, an elongated penis, and a menstrual cycle that begins at a much later time than it does for most of their peers.

Senior Engagement Deadline Disorder happens when a young adult girl or a young adult boy becomes so desperate to find a fiancé before graduating from high school or from college that they will agree to consummate any relationship that they can find with a graphic sexual experience. That is a primary way that female undergraduate college students are injured before they graduate from college.

These are some of the types of challenges that our young adults will face in their lives. It is very difficult for our young adults to deal with raging hormones disorders. We need to sponsor research studies to see how we can get them medical treatment in the future.

Young Adults and Understanding Sexual Intercourse

There is no reason why we should prohibit our young adults from understanding the mechanisms and the processes of sexual intercourse. Understanding sexual intercourse and the biology of the male reproductive system and of the female reproductive system will not hurt our young adults. Our young adults should understand the basic mechanisms that are in place when God decides to create a new human life in God's Factory of Human Life inside of a woman's body.

The biology of the male reproductive system and of the biology female reproductive system are parts of our relationship with God. We use our reproductive system to work with God to conceive and to give birth to a new human life or new human lives. There is nothing that should be offensive about understanding these issues as far as young adults are concerned.

We cannot continue to marry a young adult woman and a young adult man and to have them to not know anything about sexual intercourse or how to work with God to conceive a human life on their wedding night. We need to make sure that our young adults will get the proper training about how sexual intercourse works while they are still virgins. We have to guide them to find God before they make the decision to lose their virginity. We have to teach them that they have to be on good terms with God in order to make their first sexual experience successful and productive. We must teach them to reach out to God when they want to experience sexual activity for the first time.

Abortion and God's Factory of Human Life

Doctors must understand that a woman's reproductive system is His Factory of Human Life. It is God and only God that makes the decision to create a human life inside of a woman or to terminate the human life that He has created inside of a woman's body.

We have no right to destroy the human life that God creates at any stage of its development. That include the fetal stage, the baby stage, the toddler stage, the child stage, the young adult stage, and/or the adult stage. A human being that exists in God's Factory of Human Life is in the fetal stage of human development. God and only God is responsible for the fate and/or destiny of any human being that exists in the fetal stage of human development.

We do not have any right to enter God's Factory of Human Life and to declare that we have the authorization to destroy human being in its fetal stage that He has created. We have no right to destroy a human life in its fetal stage of development because we are not the ones that create a human being in its fetal stage inside of a woman's body and inside of God's Factory of Human Life.

Destroying a human life at the beginning of his or her life disrupts God's mission to create and to sustain all human life. God creates all human life because that is His self-appointed purpose to exist in His Universe. We must respect Him, admire Him, and love Him for the opportunity that He has given us to exist as part of His Universe and as part of Humanity.

Destroying something like a new human life makes no sense. Why do we engage in sexual activity if we have nothing to gain from it? Is a baby so bad for us that we will try to destroy it because it is a side effect of ten minutes of sexual pleasure?

We have to think about God when we think about destroying a human life inside of God Factory of Human Life inside of a woman's body. Do we have the right to destroy what God is trying to create inside of her? What do we gain by destroying the human life that God is creating inside of her?

The Benefits of Achieving Parenthood

Family planning counselors should be involved in helping our young adults to make decisions about their sexual orientation. Our young adults should understand what the different types of sexual orientation mean and the health risks that are involved with different types of sexual orientation.

Our family planning counselors should talk to our young adults about the benefits of achieving parenthood. Our young adults would consider a heterosexual orientation. Parenthood would give their lives meaning and purpose. Parenthood would help them to find God in their lives. Parenthood would help them to make a substantial contribution to the entire community of our human brothers and sisters throughout the world.

Family planning counselors can also talk to our young adults about choosing a homosexual orientation. Our family planning counselors would talk to these young adults about strategies that they can employ to avoid becoming infected with dangerous sexually transmitted diseases. They can talk about strategies to find a partner that is not infected with a sexually transmitted disease.

The role for family planning counselors in the care of heterosexual young adults would be to prepare them for marriage and parenthood. The role for family planning counselors with homosexual young adults would be to help them to avoid the infections of sexually transmitted diseases.

God and Young Adults Negotiate Marriage

There will come a time in a relationship between a man and a woman when God will want to put pressure on both of them to become engaged to be married. God will make that decision for many different reasons. God could sense the intense love that the boyfriend and the girlfriend have for each other. God could notice the compatibility that they have for each other. God can notice that they have the right chemistry to work together to become parents with children that He could present to them.

The dating situation between a young adult boy and a young adult girl does not last forever as far as God is concerned. God will eventually require the young adult boy to propose marriage to the young adult girl. He usually would want that to happen in a college before graduation. God basically does not really have a general presence as to where the proposal will take place.

The most overwhelming feeling of happiness that a young adult woman can experience would be a marriage proposal from her young adult boyfriend. God has a big influence as to whether she will say yes or no. God usually likes the woman to say yes. God likes to put a lot of pressure on the woman to say yes. God wants a proposal to work most of the time.

Young adults need to understand that a marriage proposal is an implied contract with God that they will work together in a marriage and will eventually come to have children together. They should understand that God wants them to enjoy the rest of their lives together. God does not want their marriage to end because of irreconcilable conflicts. God wants them to understand that they have to make sure that they do not have irreconcilable conflicts before the wedding.

God is very hopeful that He will be able to produce beautiful children with a newly engaged young adult couple in the future.

God, the Holy Spirit, and Firearms

God and the Holy Spirit want all of us to understand that there is no reason why anyone of us should possess any type of firearm at all. Firearms are bad for all of our young adults. We can use a firearm once to rob a bank or to injure someone with a gunshot. Our life would end after that. We would disappear from the face of the Earth into a dungeon of suffering and grief. That dungeon is a prison.

God does not want any of His sons or daughters to disappear off of the face of the Earth and to go to prison. God and the Holy Spirit do not want us to hurt ourselves or to hurt each other with any type of weapon or with any type of explosive. God does not want us to have a concealed firearm that would give us the potential to hurt ourselves and/or to hurt others.

Prison is a dead-end street for all of us. It is the final consequence of sustaining a conflict with God that would ultimately lead us to attempt to destroy human life with a weapon. God and the Holy Spirit want to save our lives and our freedom by detaching us from weapons, firearms, and explosives. It should be the collective mission for all of our schools to make sure that our young adults are convinced to reject the possession of all weapons and firearms for their entire lives. That is a mission from God for every school in the world.

God and the Holy Spirit want the killing and the violence to stop. God wants us to stop fantasizing about hurting ourselves and about hurting others with firearms. God and the Holy Spirit want us to work with our young adults to make sure that they reject all weapons and firearms.

More Constructive Relationships with God

God wants to play a more active role in the lives of our young adults. God wants to have a better line of communication with each and every one of His young adults. God wants His relationships with His young adults to be constructive and to accomplish goals that He would set for them.

God and the Holy Spirit want to work together to save the lives of our young adults. They want our young adults to stop failing and to stop facing incarceration. God and the Holy Spirit want our young adults to understand the difference between right and wrong. They want our young adults to understand the consequences of committing crimes. They want our young adults to understand the dangers of engaging in high-risk sexual behaviors.

God is forgiving Supreme Being. God is there to forgive us for our crimes, for our sins, and for everything else that we do wrong. God has nothing to gain by finding reasons and excuses to punish us. God has nothing to gain by causing us to feel pain and suffering when He authorizes Humanity to punish us by making us feel pain and suffering.

God wants our young adults to have a constructive relationship with Him that seeks to accomplish goals that are of benefit to the entire Human Family. God wants all of us to work with young adults that have been challenged by making mistakes that have caused them to hurt themselves and that have caused them to hurt others. We must mentor our young adults to build relationships with God that will play positive roles in all of our lives.

We must help young adults to understand that they all answer to God and to the entire Human Family.

Young Adults to Achieve Higher Learning

God wants His young adults to achieve a higher level of learning all of the time. God leads our young adults to understand wisdom and logical thinking. God helps our young adults to understand how to make the right decisions about their relationships, their academic endeavors, their careers, and their relationship with God.

Life is a learning process for young adults. God is at the center of that learning experience. God wants to help our young adults to understand the difference between right and wrong. God wants our young adults to understand how to be responsible with their sexual behaviors. God wants to provide psychiatric treatment and psychological counseling for all of His young adults that want to hurt themselves and that want to hurt others because of an untreated psychiatric disorder.

God wants all adults to understand how the loving intimacy between a man and a woman that will work with God to conceive and to create a new human life. God wants all young adults to have this training regardless of what sexual orientation they choose to pursue in their lives. God wants all young adults to understand how they can benefit from achieving parenthood.

God expects young adults to honor Him by not committing crimes, by loving others, by respecting Him, and by being committed to contributing to the overall greatness of God's Human Family. God educates young adults Himself, through parents, and through educators. God educates young adults through psychiatrists and therapists. God teaches our young adults how to show love and affection toward others. God also warns our young adults about the dangers that they will face if they engage in high-risk sexual behaviors. Young adults have to take God's warnings seriously.

Young Adults Cannot Hurt Themselves

God and the Holy Spirit cannot just watch young adults that are conspiring to hurt themselves and/or to hurt others without trying to intervene in their lives. God and the Holy Spirit desperately try to reach God young adults that are on the road to self-destruction and incarceration. God cries when His young adults begin to disintegrate when no one care about them and no one can save their lives.

The goals of the Criminal Justice System and psychiatry would be to rescue our young adults from making a fatal mistake that would lead to their incarceration. God and the Holy Spirit work with the Criminal Justice System to discipline our young adults so that they will stop hurting themselves and they will stop hurting others. God wants Criminal Justice System to work with psychiatrists and therapists to convince the young adult that a life of crime and incarceration is not what they want to achieve for themselves.

God and the Holy Spirit have special relationships with our young adults. God does not want our young adults to make the mistake of causing an under aged unplanned pregnancy. God does not want any of His young adults to become candidates for the infection of a sexually transmitted disease. God does not want our young adults to be candidates to abuse illegal drugs and alcohol.

God will do anything to save the lives of our young adults. God wants to help all of them to lead successful lives. Early intervention is so important in reaching young adults that might be headed toward self-destruction. God wants to work with educators and parents to do everything that they can in order to save the lives of troubled young adults.

Our goal is always to teach our young adults to not be a threat to themselves or a threat to others. That is how we will always save the lives of our children.

How Does God Discipline Young Adults?

God has to work with parents and educators to help young adults to make it perfectly clear that certain behaviors are absolutely illegal and are unacceptable. God does not want anyone to hurt a young adult in the process of discipline. God wants discipline to be painless and constructive. We must show love for our young adults by helping them to understand the difference between right and wrong without hurting them.

God tries to help our young adults himself. God communicates with our young adults all of the time. Young adults do not always pick up on it. They do not recognize the power of God that is trying to communicate with them and that is trying to help them. God likes to give young adults good ideas about how to behave the right way in different situations. God tries to help young adults to understand the benefits of proper behavior as opposed to the consequences of destructive behaviors.

God wants our psychiatrists, therapists, educators, parents, and law enforcement officers to teach our young adults how to function as part of society the right way. We must take drugs off of the streets by convincing our young adults to reject substance abuse entirely. We must stop drunk driving. We must stop our young adults from believing that substance abuse is beneficial to them at all.

God wants our young adults to understand that there is no purpose for violence. God wants all of us, especially His young adults, to understand the consequences of engaging in violence. God wants all of our young adults to understand that we need to live at peace with our human brothers and sisters in a situation that is free of violence and hatred. Young adults need to stop endorsing violence.

How Do Young Adults Prepare for Adulthood?

God and the Holy Spirit play big roles in the way that young adults mature into adults. God helps His young adults to achieve their destiny. A person's destiny is a plan that God has for a person when the person is born that outlines God's vision for that person's eventual role within God's Human Family.

God has to negotiate with our young adults in order to reveal their destinies to each and every one of them. God must try to convince them to work with Him to achieve that destiny. Young adults must welcome the help of God and of the Holy Spirit in helping them to prepare for the destiny that God has chosen for them.

Young adults that ultimately achieve their destiny find that their life is joyful and fulfilling. These adults love God. They feel that God is a special part of everything that they do in their lives. They want to give something back to God for everything that God has given to them that contributes to their happiness.

We make the people that deal with us very happy and proud to deal with us when we have achieved our destiny. We always help those of us that need our help under the supervision of God because we have come to love God and to love our brother and sisters of Humanity.

Our loved ones celebrate our success when we finally achieve our destiny for God. We bring pride and honor to our parents and to our loved ones. Our loved ones will never forget the first day that we will show up for work after we have been certified to function in our profession that was related to our destiny.

God loves us when we are young adults. He wants to prepare us for the role that we will play as part of Humanity. God wants all of us to show love and affection to all of our brothers and sisters that we will affect in our lives for the rest of our lives.

God prepares us of adulthood by supervising our efforts to achieve our destiny and by giving us the tools, the training, and the resources to achieve success while our young adults are trying to achieve their destinies.

The Adult Years

God Has a Plan for All Adults

God has a plan for all of us when we become adults. God helps us to function as parents for those of us that have decided to pursue and/or to achieve parenthood. God guides us to become successful in our profession and career. God guides us to be the best possible parents that we can be.

We have to remember that all children come from God. We have a responsibility to God to raise our children who are also His children the right way. Parenthood and marriage can be stressful. God is there to help us when we begin our adult lives. God is there to continue to help us beyond the beginning of our adult lives.

There is nowhere to go to receive training in how to be the perfect spouse or the perfect parent. However, that kind of understanding comes from an adult's relationship with God. God teaches us how to be outstanding parents and how to be an outstanding spouse. God shows us how to show love for our spouse and for our children. God shows us how to find happiness in our lives by giving us the gift of the love of our spouse and children in our lives for the rest of our lives.

There are times when things can go wrong. A child may become ill. A child may have a disability. A marriage may disintegrate. A husband might engage in an affair. A husband or a wife can lose his or her job. God develops a plan to help us as adults when things go horribly wrong. God is there to help a family to cope with pain and hardship. God is there to help a family to recover from a disaster such as a parent's loss of a job.

We must work to discover God's plan for us through prayer so that we can respond to the love that He has for us. That is the way that God can work with us to save our lives if something goes wrong with us.

Understanding Legality Versus a Crime

God and the Holy Spirit want our adults to understand the difference between what is a crime and what is not a crime. Millions of people have used illegal drugs. Millions of peoples' lives have been destroyed because they have tried to accomplish something with firearms. How many tens-of-thousands of people are critically injured by driver that driving while intoxicated?

God and the Holy Spirit want adults to understand that they do not need to become incarcerated because of the use of a firearm to commit a crime. God and the Holy Spirit do not want adults to feel good about the way that they destroy themselves with illegal drugs. God and the Holy Spirit cry when someone is killed or seriously injured by a drunk driver.

Coming to understand the difference between what is a crime and what is not a crime is part of an adult's relationship with God. God help's adults to understand the difference between right and wrong. God helps adults to understand what a crime is. God wants His adults to always listen to Him and to the Holy Spirit when they will warn him or her about the consequences that they will face if he or she proceeds to commit a crime.

God and the Holy Spirit are the ultimate resources that we have to help us to understand the difference between what is right and what is wrong. We should always respond to them.

Heterosexual Adults and God

Heterosexual adults understand their obligation to God to work with Him and with a partner of the opposite gender to participate in the process of the conception, the birth, and the development of new human lives. Heterosexual adults find happiness and fulfillment in their relationship with God when He awards them the gift of a new human life.

The purpose of God is to continue to create human and nonhuman life for the rest of eternity. God prides himself as being a factory that produces an endless amount of human and nonhuman life. God wants to continue to find heterosexual couples that will help Him to find even more ways to love the members of His Human Family.

God wants to give heterosexuals the financial capability that they will need to develop babies, toddlers, children, and young adults. God wants to help parents to continue to remain in their jobs. God wants parents to stay together without becoming divorced. God wants children to feel the love and affection of their parents. God wants children to contribute to the happiness of their family members as well as of God's entire Human Family. Heterosexual adults honor God when they accept the burden of achieving parenthood. Heterosexual adults help God to fulfill His purpose and His self-appointed destiny.

Heterosexual adults help God to recycle the souls of dead people into new lives by the process of reincarnation. It is always a joy for God to have the opportunity to bring back a lost soul from a previous life into a new life. God always wants to give us a second chance by giving us a new life when a previous life has expired.

Heterosexual work with God to make sure that human lives will continue to be born and that they will continue to be developed into the framework of God's Human Family.

God and the Holy Spirit Guide Parents

There are times when parents may confront a family crisis. It could be a crisis within the family. It could be a behavioral crisis with their children. It could be a financial problem. The one thing that we must understand about God is that He feels pain when families start to disintegrate. God and the Holy Spirit want to do everything that they can do to save a marriage from collapse and to save a family from falling apart.

God and the Holy Spirit like to guide parents into marriage counseling as a last resort in order to try to get them professional therapy as a final option to save their marriage. Marriage counselors work for God. Their destiny was to work as a psychotherapist that would counsel husbands and wives that would be considering getting a divorce.

God wants a husband and a wife to remember the day of birth of their first child. God wants them to remember their wedding day. God wants them to remember the joy that they brought into God's life and into the lives of God's Human Family. God wants them to remember the promise that they made to Him to stay together for the rest of their lives.

God and the Holy Spirit want to intervene in the lives of a married couple that may be facing a divorce. Their goal is to save the marriage and to save the family that supports God's young children and God's young adults. They want to save the marriage of a husband and wife that have belonged together since God introduced them to each other. God will love them no matter what happens.

Understanding the Needs of Young Adults

Young adults can have all kinds of problems. They have to decide their sexual orientation. They have to discover their destiny. They have to develop a network of friendships with peers. They have to deal with performing in their schools. We can force young adults to function under an enormous amount of stress.

When do parents allow a young adult to begin to date either members of the same gender or members of the opposite gender? When is it appropriate to talk with young adults about issues such as birth control, sexually transmitted diseases, substance abuse, unplanned pregnancies, rape, and sexual exploitation? Are parents too embarrassed to talk to their young adults about the issues? Why do educators completely talk about these issues?

Under aged dating is very dangerous. Heterosexual under aged dating can lead to efforts to engage in sexual activity by the young adult boy and the young adult girl. Can the young girl's parents endorse their daughter's use of birth control if she decides to become sexually active? Will the young boy's parents actually agree to pay for their birth control? What would sexual activity among these minors actually accomplish?

Young adults do not need sexual activity to sustain a normal level of functioning. However, there is always that desire and/or curiosity about sexual activity that stays in their mind until they actually start having sexual relations in a relationship.

Who talks to homosexual young adults about high-risk behaviors and sexually transmitted diseases? Is it safe for parents to allow a young adult homosexual teenager to date considering the probability that this teenager may become infected with a sexually transmitted disease? How do we teach homosexual teenagers to protect themselves against becoming infected with sexually transmitted diseases such as HIV?

Our schools have a lot of work to do if they are going to help our young adults to understand the serious and life-threatening dangers that they will face if they continue to behave recklessly during under aged dating. God is at a point where He will no longer tolerate high-risk sexual behaviors.

God Guides the Process of Fertility

It may be difficult for parents to understand how to achieve a pregnancy. God coaches them as to how to approach sexual intimacy the right way so that they will be able to work with Him to achieve the conception of a new human life.

God helps the husband and wife to understand the woman's menstrual cycle. God helps the husband and wife to understand when the right exact time to have sexual intercourse exists so that they can work with God to conceive a human life.

Some women will not admit that they are embarrassed when they have to manipulate the time that they will have sexual intercourse with their husband to the exact time that they will be ovulating. The whole process is very complicating and is very stressful. This is especially true for a woman.

God has the unrelenting determination to make sure that every husband and wife will have the opportunity to enjoy the benefits and the happiness that comes with parenthood and with bringing a new human life into the world.

Dealing with Humanity That is in a Crisis

God and the Holy Spirit are in a state of emergency. Our brothers and sisters throughout the world are very sick. Our brother and sisters have been planning schemes to try to destroy human life while destroy their own lives simultaneously. Many of them hate the United States. Many of the live in the United States.

We must work with God and with the Holy Spirit when to try to find ways to get psychiatric treatment to all of us that are mentally ill before any of us will go over the edge and will devastate humanity.

Our goal as adults is not to justify the death and destruction of human life. Our goal is not to persistently attack human life because we think that our mentally ill brothers and sisters are out to hurt us and to kill us. What is the real reason why we would not have sympathy for those of us that are so mentally ill that they suffer a total detachment from God and a total detachment from humanity? An effort to kill such suicidal persons is similar to trying to kill a ghost.

It has come to a point where we can no longer allow our schools to graduate mentally ill students without identifying that they have a mental illness. We must make sure that we can treat our mentally ill students before they graduate from our schools so that it will be less likely that they will become insane in front of God and in front of society.

We must find those of us that are desperate to hurt themselves and/or to hurt others. We must try to save their lives and the live of who would have been their victims. Our mental health professionals need to see the human being in people that are suicidal and homicidal at the same time. We can save our brothers and sisters grief and pain all over the world by acknowledging the grievances that they have against us and by resolving those grievances through peaceful confrontation and not through violence. We think that God would want that from us.

We Can Discover the Purpose of God

God is a Factory of Life. God is responsible for operating the entire universe. God is responsible for creating all human and nonhuman life. God is responsible for working with adults to conceive, to give birth, and to develop human life.

God plays special roles in all of our everyday lives. God wants to talk with us about our issues, our concerns, our grievances, and situations that confuse us. We have a loving God that all of us to help Him to help us. God has created us and sustains our existence because He needs our love in His life. God needs us to recognize that He exists for all of us because of the love that he has for us.

God cries when He sees a suicide and/or wrongful deaths. It is amazing that we do not think about God's suffering when He loses human lives to senseless violence that stands against everything that He has ever taught us to honor through His prophets.

We stop hating each other when we discover the purpose of God. We embrace the brothers and sisters that shared a mutual hatred with us and cry in each other's arms as we beg God to forgive us for causing the pain and suffering that we have put Him through. We stop hating our brothers and sisters all over the world when we find God. Our brothers and sisters all over the world stop hating us. The hateful thoughts that drive our need to hurt ourselves and to hurt other at the same time will disappear and will be replaced by loving thought from God and from the Holy Spirit.

Discipline Through Peaceful Confrontation

We have to take God seriously when He will tell us that we are about to do something wrong. We have to understand that God wants to use peaceful discipline that will not hurt us in order to help us to understand that we are doing something wrong. God does not believe that discipline and torture should be the same thing. God want adult discipline to be painless and productive.

God might tell a father to not let his daughter to date a new boyfriend. God may feel that this boyfriend might try to rape his daughter and might try to get her pregnant. These kids might just be in high school. How do parents feel about that warning?

There is always an ever-present danger that the boyfriend and the daughter might lose control of each other and may decide to become sexual in the relationship. Should the father trust his instincts about what God wants him to do or should he have an I-do-not-care attitude toward the situation between his daughter and her boyfriend?

It is so important for adults to understand that they need help from God and from the Holy Spirit in order to make life-saving decisions about their young-adult sons and/or daughters. Fathers and mothers are not there to there to hear the bad news. My son is HIV Positive as a junior in high school and my daughter is pregnant as a sophomore in high school.

It is important for parents to pray to God and to seek help, counseling, and support so that they can prevent a disaster that might happen to their young adult sons and daughters. God and the Holy Spirit is a presence in the lives of all parents from the time that God created the children in His Factory of Human Life. God wants all of His parents and His children and young adults to be successful in their lives.

Developing a Personal Relationship with God

Why should adults develop a personal relationship with God? We all respond to a relationship with God. We eat food that comes from God. We drink fluids that come from God. All of our homes contain materials that come from God. Practically everything that our engineers have ever invented is composed of substances and materials that come from nature and from God.

We are all part of God. God has a special presence in our lives when we are adults. That is because God wants us to help Him to find deal with Humanity. God wants to employ us in a specific role from within the human race. God helps us to find ways to understand how to function in that role. We develop a personal relationship with God because we have to rely on God's guidance in order to perform job tasks that are related to what God wants us to do for Him.

Everybody needs advice from our Supreme Being. Everybody needs guidance from our Supreme Being. We have to try to understand the role that God has been playing in our lives. We have to understand how to perform our role in God's life.

A personal relationship with God can accomplish a lot for all adults. God can be nice to us and can help us to construct a new invention. God might help us to guide our son to meet his future fiancé. God might guide us to get that incredible job and may continue to help us to keep that job.

God is always present in our lives. Therefore, it makes common sense that adults should find a way to develop a personal relationship with God.

Seeking a New Beginning with God

There are many problems that can severely damage our relationship with God. We can commit a crime. We can hurt our spouse or our other family members. We can hurt ourselves. The damage from our actions can range from being minor to being extremely extensive. We may express the malicious intent to inflict pain and harm upon others. How do we rebuild our life and our relationship with God when it is over?

We must show remorse for what we have done wrong in front of God. We must show regret for the way that we have hurt ourselves and for the way that we have hurt others. We must go to God to ask Him what He would need us to do to repair the damage that we have caused by Him and by hurting our fellow brothers and sisters. We must be sincere in our efforts to convince God that we will never offend Him like this again if He could be merciful with us by forgiving us for what we have done wrong.

We cannot seek a new beginning with God if we persist in having hateful thoughts that give us the motivations and the excuses to believe that we have to continue to injure and kill God's children and that we will not be held responsible because of it. We cannot find a new beginning with God if we think that murdering another human being or other human beings is something that God will tolerate from us. Murder is murder and murder is never justified. The only being that has the authorization to take a human life is God.

Our schools are not teaching our students to reject the use of firearms and explosives. Why are we not teaching our young adults to reject the types of crimes that will severely damage our relationship with God and that would cause severe suffering for Humanity in our schools? Do adults know the difference between right and wrong when they graduate from our grammar schools and our high schools? Do our schools groom our students for incarceration?

Adults sometimes discover that what they have done wrong is a crime and a sin. The only thing that they can do after the authorities have caught them committing crimes is to ask God for mercy. That is when adults need a new beginning with God. God forgives them for what they have done wrong. The criminal justice system then tries to forgive them for what they have done wrong.

God then welcomes us back into His Human Community. We will be smarter the next time around when God will help us to avoid committing crimes and will help us to succeed as law-abiding adults.

Stimulating Our Children's Relationships with God

We have a responsibility to God to introduce our young children to prayer and to talking to God on a daily basis. We have to let our children to understand that God is a powerful force that exists in their lives and that He wants guide children to do good things for others.

Parents can maximize the chances that the children will not fall away from God later in their lives by teaching them how to pray and how to communicate with God when they start school. God will be better able to teach our kids the difference between right and wrong. God will be able to guide children to become more responsible and more intelligent young adults if the child can start to respond to His love and affection when they start school.

We all want God to our students to learn how to read. We want God to teach our students to learn how to speak, how to count, how to understand arithmetic, and how to spell words. God has a partnership with all of our teachers. God loves our teachers. That is why teaching was the destiny of those who became licensed teachers when they were in high school. God loves our teachers. God loves to work with our teachers in order to stimulate the success of our young students.

God loves it when he would put a first-grade student in front of a reading textbook and to hear the young student reciting what he is reading in front of him. No one thinks about the role that God plays in giving students the ability to read for the first time. Not many people give God credit for further assisting teachers in the development of their students' reading and math skills.

Teachers and parents can maximize that their student will be successful by making sure that the student will pray and talk to God on a daily basis. The student has to be willing to recognize and to embrace the love that God will show for him or her when God tries to help him or her to read for the first time.

God's Help in a Substance Abuse Crisis

God is very hurt and very offended when an adult has chosen to completely ruin his or her life by either dealing drugs on the streets or by abusing illegal drugs to satisfy an addiction to drugs.

This is God's Human Community. God will not tolerate the way that His sons and daughters will hurt themselves with illegal drugs. Sometimes it is God himself who forces an adult into a Substance Abuse Rehabilitation Program. God wants to save the lives of those that are addicted to illegal drugs, painkillers, and alcohol.

Drug dealers on the streets do not understand that that selling substances that people use to make themselves sick is something that God does not allow. God will not tolerate either substance abuse or drug dealing.

We do, however, have a very forgiving God. God wants substance abusers and drug dealers to get help and to get real jobs after the finish Substance Abuse Rehabilitation. God has a way of breaking into the lives of people that want to hurt themselves and to hurt others. God tries to help these people. However, there is limit that God can deal with before He will become violent.

God can give drug dealers and money launderers what they deserve for seeking to injure and to destroy the lives of tens-of-millions of people. They might have the option of showing remorse for what they have done and may work with God and addiction doctors to rebuild their lives.

Conclusion

God Loves Us Through Our Lives

God loves us from the time that He conceives us in His Factory of Human Life inside of our mother's body to the time that we become elderly people.

God's love for us helps us produce achievements in our academic life, our careers, and our academic endeavors. We exchange love between ourselves and God because that helps us to accomplish our destiny and to achieve success in our relationships. Exchanging between ourselves and God helps to give God the feeling that He has or is achieving His goal of creating and maintaining intelligent human lives that will always love Him.

God expects us to recognize His Existence in our lives from the time that we are young children. Young children begin to feel the presence of God in their lives when they begin to learn how to read, how to write, and how to understand arithmetic. God stimulates children to be sociable with other children and with other adults such as teachers.

God's love for us will eventually help us to achieve parenthood if we choose to work with God toward achieving parenthood. Our relationship with God can help us to do so many things to help to make the community that we live in a much more beautiful place to live. We show our love for God when we show love for others by helping them when they need help from us.

All of our achievements help us to answer back to God. God is responsible for helping all of us to achieve success in our relationship, in our schools, and in our careers.

We Must Understand Our Destiny

God decides what role He wants each and every one of us to play from within our human family. That role is called our destiny. Our destiny is what God finally expects us to achieve with ourselves so that we can find a career and a social network that is best suited for our relationship with God.

God needs us to assume a certain role within Humanity when toddlers. God hopes that these kids will agree with Him to pursue the career of His choosing when they enter college. He is also a matchmaker that hopes that he can set up every young adult with a perfect fiancé.

It is to the benefit of our children, their parents, and Humanity for our students to discover the destiny that comes to them from God. Students must decide their career path when they are in high school. A student must work with God to understand why he or she would be a perfect match for a certain type of school, for a certain type of major, and/or a certain type of career.

Students that achieve their destiny work to help Humanity to come closer to God. People that have achieved their destiny help God to reach all of His sons and daughters. People that achieved their destiny can be role models for our young adults who also have to make decisions about their compatibility with their destiny.

We sometimes fail to achieve our destiny for some reason. We then achieve our fate. Our fate can be influenced by several different factors. God is involved in repairing the damage that caused one of His sons or daughters to completely fall short of His expectations. God has to work with the person to see if there are other possible academic programs and careers that our young adult can pursue.

God Expects Us to Develop New Human Lives

God expects us to work with a partner of the opposite gender at some point in our lives to conceive and to give birth to a new human life. Our reproductive organs help us to have a direct connection to God. This direct connection to God is what gives God the authorization to begin to assemble a human life inside of God's Factory of Human Life inside of a woman.

God is very hurt and very disappointed when so many of us choose to refuse to pursue and to achieve parenthood. He does not understand why there are men that think that they can make men pregnant or women that think that they can make women pregnant.

The one thing that most of us do not understand is that we all answer to God when we use our reproductive organs and reproductive fluids with another partner. God expects these organs and these fluids to be used exclusively to create a human life. God can be intimidated sexual behaviors that work to accomplish nothing as far as a pregnancy is concerned.

God is so angry that He has created epidemics of sexually transmitted diseases. We have to very careful when we now understand that we can get a sexually transmitted disease if we continue to humiliate and to intimidate God with our sexual behaviors.

We do not think about God when we engage in sexual behaviors. It is important to think about how God is punishing this human family with sexually transmitted diseases because of the way that they are behaving with their sexual organs. We all should pray for those who have sexually transmitted diseases and should pray that we may be spared from getting a sexually transmitted disease in the future.

What is an Abortion?

God is solely the Creator of all Human Life and nonhuman life. God creates a new human life in His Factory of Human Life inside of the body of a pregnant woman. God's decision to create a human life inside of His Factory of Human Life is His decision and only His decision. We have no right to justify the destruction of a human life whose creation is under development by God.

An abortion is an effort to completely destroy God's efforts to create a human life inside of a woman. We do not have the right to destroy God's activities to create a human life inside of a woman's body because we do not create human life. God and only God creates human life.

Medical doctors are supposed to embrace the birth and the development of human lives. They work with God to make the lives of our kids healthier and free of disease. Does God's need doctors that try to destroy His efforts to create a human life inside of a woman after He has initiated the process of conception?

No one has the authority to destroy what God tries to accomplish inside of the body of a pregnant woman except for God when He decides to abort a pregnancy by causing a miscarriage. The decision to end the pregnancy as a miscarriage is God's decision and only God's decision.

We cannot be disrespectful to God by allowing woman to believe that childbirth is a bad thing for them. It is a bad thing for the government to believe that it could convince women that ten minutes of passion should result in the life-long loss of a human life. We have to think about how we are going to explain this to God in the future.

What God Finally Expects from All of Us

God expects us to respect all human life. God expects all of us show love and compassion for those of us that want to hurt themselves and to hurt others because they have an untreated mental illness and because they are suffering from a Detachment from God.

We must show love for God by trying to developing our children and young adults to love God and to reject the illness of the Detachment from God. This Detachment from God will lead them to believe that they have something to gain by hurting themselves and by hurting others. It is better to work with God to help these people than to fantasize about elevating God's pain and suffering by trying to use violence against them and/or trying to kill them.

The need to hurt oneself concurrently with a need to hurt others at the same time is the result of a chronic psychiatric illness. It does not mean that a person that has this problem is evil. It does not mean that we have the right to attack and to kill these people in response to the threat to our lives that we believe exists because of their aggression and their willingness to injure and to kill human beings.

We have to work with God to provide psychiatric counseling to people that are this mentally ill and that are this detached from God. We have nothing to gain by fantasizing about killing them. We have nothing to gain by dropping bombs on them. They make themselves suffer when they fantasize about betraying God by injuring and destroying human life. We should feel sorry for them when their purpose in life is that detached from God and from Humanity.

Our medical community and our Armed Forces must try to have sympathy to those of us that have such a severe mental illness that they have caused us to develop a severe mental illness. We are so paranoid. We think that a suicide bomber is always out to try to kill us somewhere out there. There are not many people out there that would agree to kill themselves and to kill others at the same time. Over 99.99% of the human population of this planet would have nothing to do with a suicide attack or a suicide bombing.

We need to get people that have problems with suicidal thinking psychiatric assistance. We need to find these people and we need to medically treat them for Chronic Major Depression. We need to help them to understand that the God that loves all of us loves those of us that get sick and that want to accomplish something by hurting themselves and by hurting others. Maybe we need to teach them how to pray. Maybe we need to help them the benefits of rejoining humanity as part of God.

We have to reach our Muslim children and Muslim young adults. We need to teach them that the entire Western World loves all of our Muslim brothers and sisters. We have to teach God's Muslim children and His young adults that we are sorry for the way that we have hurt Muslims in the past. God would want to stand in front of His Muslim kids and ask them nicely to become a productive part of Humanity rather than to pursuing a lost cause of wanting hurt God and to hurt Humanity for no reason.

Muhammad was a wonderful prophet. He did not want Islam to progress to a point where Humanity would come to believe that Muslims would be out to hurt us. We have no right to fantasize about attacking and killing God's Muslims. We have to grow up. We have to stop God's suffering. We have end our suffering. We have to provide psychiatric treatment and psychological counseling to all of those of us that want to betray God and Humanity by committing suicide and homicide at the same time. We must honor God by helping our severely mentally ill brothers and sisters.
